BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to California District 28 Little League (\$3,000.00) will support their Youth Access and Safety Initiative Project, which provides player scholarships, safety equipment, and shared team resources for youth baseball and softball programs. This funding will help ensure young athletes have equitable access to participate in organized sports while promoting safe play and teamwork throughout the community.
2. The donation to the Temescal Heritage Foundation (\$5,000.00) will support the Annual Community Faire, which brings together residents, local businesses, and service providers in the unincorporated area of Temescal Valley. The event provides an opportunity for community members to learn more about local resources while fostering civic engagement and community connection.
3. The donation to the Riverside County Fire Department (\$5,000.00) will provide funding for the first Women in Fire Service event, which aims to educate, inspire, and recruit women and high school students interested in careers within the fire service. The event highlights career pathways, mentorship opportunities, and hands-on demonstrations to encourage greater representation of women in the fire profession.

4. The donation to the Riverside County Department of Public Social Services – Office of Child Abuse Prevention (\$5,000.00) will support the 2026 Child Abuse Prevention Summit, focused on raising awareness and strengthening prevention efforts throughout Riverside County. The summit will bring together community partners, professionals, and advocates to address child abuse, neglect, maltreatment, and exploitation through education and collaborative solutions.
5. The donation to the Orange Grove High School Booster Club (\$4,000.00) will assist with support of student enrichment programs including a girl's empowerment group, male leadership development group, agricultural education opportunities, and the athletic club. These programs provide students with leadership development, skill-building opportunities, and positive engagement both in and outside the classroom.
6. The donation to the Law Enforcement Appreciation Committee (\$5,000.00) will support the Annual Law Enforcement Appreciation and Recognition Ceremony, which honors peace officers for their service and dedication to protecting the community. The event recognizes the risks officers face daily while strengthening relationships between law enforcement and the communities they serve.
