

1. I.E. Bombsquad Inc. is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$3,500. Funding will support equipment, travel, and tournament fees to ensure young women from financially struggling families in the Fifth District can participate in youth softball programs.
2. G1 Training & Fitness is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$2,500. Funding will support the G1 Track & Field Youth Development Program in Moreno Valley, providing athletic training, mentorship, and academic support for low-income and at-risk youth.
3. Starting Line Strength & Stability Center is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$2,500. Funding will support program operations, insurance, and equipment to ensure continued exercise classes for seniors and individuals with neurological and mobility challenges in the Fifth District.
4. Community Center for Healthy Minds is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$2,500. Funding will support workshops and training sessions addressing domestic violence, substance abuse, anger management, parenting, and other behavioral health services for underserved residents in the Fifth District.
5. Boys & Girls Clubs of the San Geronio Pass is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$2,500. Funding will support the Adulting 101 program at the Teen Center in Banning, providing college and career readiness, leadership development, and life-skills training for at-promise youth in the Fifth District.
6. Valley Restart Shelter is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$5,000. Funding will support utility connections for transitional housing units at its Hemet campus, expanding shelter capacity for families, seniors, and veterans experiencing homelessness in the Fifth District.
7. Western Center Community Foundation dba Western Science Center is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$8,400. Funding will support Science Under the Stars, the Library Pass Program, and PaleoCon, expanding access to science education and community programming for residents of the Fifth District.
8. Cherries of the Pass Foundation is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$20,000. Funding will support the Annual Cherry Festival and Fair, a longstanding community event promoting local heritage, economic activity, and family-friendly engagement in the Fifth District.
9. Banning Stagecoach Days Association is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$500 to support their annual Stagecoach Days event benefiting residents of the Fifth District.

Funding will support community programs in Moreno Valley that provide food distribution, youth development activities, outreach services, and financial literacy education for low-income families and individuals throughout the Fifth District.
