- By Supervisor Perez: John Rios, a beloved resident of Indio, who passed away on February 23, 2026. John served over 4 decades in the fire service. He began his career in the 1970's with the Coachella Fire Department. In October of 1990, John became Battalion Chief 6 at Coachella Station 79 and later transferred to Palm Desert Station 33 as Battalion Chief 12B until retiring in 2003. He also was a member of the Desert Recreation District, member of the Indio Elks lodge, little league baseball & softball coach, and 20-year volunteer for the Baskets of Love. He served as a Board of Director for the Coachella Valley Public Cemetery District.
- By Supervisor Washington: Lorraine Harrington, a beloved resident of Temecula, who passed away on February 27, 2026. She had a love horses, and at 7 years old she won her first blue ribbon at the Tulsa Innovation Horse Show. She was an accomplished scholar who earned degrees from Washington University, University of Saint Louis, and University of Kansas. She obtained a PHD in Japanese Medieval History from Stanford University. She taught Japanese history at UC Santa Cruz and Stanford University. She served a 23-year career as management consultant at McKinsey and Co. In 1999, she moved to Wine County and advocated for 27 years to help preserve the rural area of Temecula Valley.

The Board of Supervisors commemorates their service to the County of Riverside.
