

**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to God's Fan Club DBA Project Touch (\$50,000.00) will support the development of the Life Restoration Center, a transitional housing community. Funding will assist with the construction of nine 10-bedroom homes designed to serve more than 200 individuals and families who are experiencing or at risk of homelessness. This project will provide safe, stable housing and supportive resources to help residents transition toward long-term housing stability and self-sufficiency.
