BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to Corona Life Services DBA ZOI (\$3,000.00) will support services for families facing unplanned pregnancies. Funding will help provide essential resources for infants and parents, including education and support services that equip families for successful parenthood. This program promotes stability and healthy outcomes for both parents and children.
2. The donation to the Norco Fair Committee (\$6,000.00) will support the Annual Norco Fair. This long-standing community event celebrates Norco's western heritage and brings residents together through family-friendly activities, entertainment, and local engagement. Funding will assist with event operations and programming that benefit the broader community.
3. The donation to the Jurupa Valley Chamber of Commerce (\$1,500.00) will support the Annual Day of Prayer event. This gathering brings together community members, local leaders, and organizations in a shared space of reflection and unity. The event promotes community connection and civic engagement within Jurupa Valley.
4. The donation to eSTEM Ambassadors (\$5,000.00) will support hands-on STEM education programs for students and families. Participants engage in immersive learning experiences at the organization's learning lab, exploring engineering, science, and technology through interactive activities. Funding will help expand access to STEM opportunities for hundreds of students annually.

5. The donation to Riverside Sheriff's Charities (\$2,500.00) will support their annual recognition event honoring individuals for outstanding service and contributions to the community. The organization also provides assistance to veterans, victims of crime, and families of fallen officers, as well as scholarships for local youth. Funding will help sustain these community-focused programs and services.
6. The donation to the Jurupa Valley Food Fest (\$4,000.00) will support scholarship opportunities for students attending the four high schools within the Jurupa Valley Unified School District. This community event raises funds that directly benefit local students pursuing higher education. Funding will help expand scholarship availability and student support.
7. The donation to Kidz Come First (\$2,000.00) will support their Easter Basket, Blanket, and Egg Hunt event for low-income families. The program provides essential items and seasonal support to children and families in need. Funding will help ensure families have access to resources that promote well-being and community connection.
8. The donation to the American Legion Lynn Mort Post 200 (\$4,000.00) will support improvements to their outdoor patio space. This space is utilized for community food drives, veteran gatherings, and local events that serve residents and service members. Funding will help enhance the facility's ability to continue providing community-based services.
9. The donation to Nueva Vista Continuation High School (\$2,000.00) will support the expansion of their community closet and student support programs. Funding will provide basic needs kits for students and support the Evening Engagement Series, which brings families and local service providers on campus while offering meals and resources. These efforts help address student needs and strengthen family engagement.
10. The donation to the Norco Area Chamber of Commerce & Visitor's Center (\$2,500.00) will support the Business Awards and Installation Event. This event recognizes local business leaders and community members for their contributions to economic development and community engagement. Funding will assist with event programming that promotes local business growth and regional collaboration.

12. The donation to Regional Access Project (RAP) Foundation (\$10,000.00) will provide funding for RAP's NPO Centric program, which delivers professional development, technical assistance, and networking opportunities for nonprofit organizations serving Riverside County residents. This program strengthens organizational capacity,

enabling nonprofits to build, improve, and expand services that directly benefit the community.

13. The donation to the Riverside National Cemetery Support Committee (\$5,000.00) will support the Annual Concert for Heroes event. This event honors more than 300,000 veterans and family members interred at Riverside National Cemetery while celebrating the independence of the United States of America. Funding will assist with event operations that bring the community together in remembrance and tribute to those who have served.
14. The donation to Riverside County Department of Animal Services (\$10,000.00) will support the Ironwood Dog Foster Program, a collaborative initiative with Ironwood State Prison focused on improving outcomes for large, young dogs with extended shelter stays. The program enhances adoptability through training and socialization while fostering positive engagement between participants and animals, ultimately increasing successful adoptions and improving animal welfare.
15. The donation to the Corona History Association (\$5,000.00) will support the Box Car event, conducted in partnership with Corona-Norco Unified School District elementary schools. This program promotes the preservation of Corona's history by providing interactive educational presentations that engage students and foster a deeper understanding of the community's heritage.
16. The donation to Corona Chamber of Commerce (\$2,500.00) will support programs that promote economic development and business growth, including expanded networking opportunities for local businesses and community organizations. These efforts enhance engagement, strengthen the local economy, and support a thriving business environment within the Second District.
17. The donation to Michelle's Place Cancer Resource Center (\$4,000.00) will support comprehensive, no-cost services for cancer patients and their families, including patient navigation, behavioral health support, transportation assistance, and access to essential well-being supplies such as wigs and prosthetics. These services provide critical emotional, physical, and financial support to individuals navigating cancer, improving quality of life and access to care for Riverside County residents.
18. The donation to Herencia Mariachi Academy (\$4,000.00) will support culturally enriching educational programs that provide youth with instruction in mariachi music and heritage, fostering confidence, discipline, and critical life skills. Through community-based activities, students gain a deeper understanding of cultural traditions while developing self-esteem, academic focus, and meaningful connections to their community.
