

BACKGROUND:

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **City of Temecula- \$2,500-** The funds will support the Special Games, an annual event for athletes of all ages with disabilities to participate in noncompetitive games and an awards ceremony.
2. **Riverside County District Attorney’s Office- Division of Victim Services- \$3,000-** The funds will support National Crime Victims’ Rights Week, an annual event that honors and pays tribute to victims of crime and their families in our community.
3. **MilVet- \$2,500-** This funding will support the MilVet Honors Fundraiser & Gala, an annual event that raises funds for the distribution of monthly care packages for troops, a veteran food pantry, and veteran service programs.
4. **Murrieta Valley Cemetery District-\$10,000-** This funding will be used for the construction of the Laurel Cemetery Remembrance Point. This masonry monument will allow the cemetery to continue providing residents with a way to honor their deceased loved ones.

5. **Riverside County Office of Child Abuse Prevention- \$5,000-** The funding will support the Riverside County Office of Child Abuse Prevention Summit 2025-2026; an event focused on raising awareness and strengthening prevention efforts throughout Riverside County.
6. **Rock Your Red - \$2,000-** This funding will support the Rock Your Red Heart and Stroke Awareness Program, which offers hands-only CPR training as well as free seminars to educate the public about cardiovascular disease.
7. **Riverside University Health System Foundation- \$2,500-**The funding will support the RUHS Foundation's Pinwheels for Prevention program, which provides foster children who have been neglected or abused with essential items, such as toothbrushes and medical care.
8. **Riverside County Department of Public Social Services-\$4,000-** The funding will be utilized to support the 2026 Elder and Dependent Adult Abuse Symposium. This annual event raises awareness about elder or dependent adult abuse and highlights innovative approaches, programs and strategies that aim to prevent or protect the elder or dependent adult from abuse and neglect.
9. **Ca District 28 Little League-\$5,000-** The funding will be used to provide youth participation scholarships for low-income children and to purchase ball carrier nets, practice nets, and Little League softballs.
10. **Riverside County Youth Commission-\$5,000-** The funding will be utilized to support the 28th Annual Youth Summit, an annual leadership event that brings together high school students for a day of workshops, networking, and skill building activities.
