**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. About Families, Inc. was created to fill a gap in accessible, community-driven resources for parents in the Coachella Valley, from prenatal care to preschool. The Family Fall Festival is a community tradition that welcomes more than 5,000 attendees for a family-friendly celebration. This no-cost event features exhibitors and vendors focused on family wellness, resources, children's activities, live entertainment, petting zoo, food vendors and child safety demonstrations. CID funds will be used to offset the cost of this event.
2. The Boys and Girls Club of Cathedral City hosted a community Holiday Posada to provide toys, food and a joyful holiday experience for local youth and families. This event was designed to support families during a particularly challenging time by creating a safe, welcoming space filled with holiday spirit. In total, over 500 toys and more than 100 bicycles were distributed, making a meaningful impact for hundreds of children in our community. CID funds will be used towards to cost of toys and food.
3. The Regional Access Project (RAP) Foundation serves as the fiscal agent for the scholarship fund for the Fourth District Youth Advisory Council (YAC). YAC members are high school students who participate in monthly community and county service projects in the Fourth District. Students who have served in Fourth District YAC receive a scholarship to help their future academic needs. CID funds will go to the RAP foundation to support the scholarship fund.
4. The Riverside Sheriffs Association and the Riverside County Deputy Sheriff Relief Foundation hosted their annual golf tournament to raise funds that support the families of fallen officers and provide critical assistance to deputies and their families during times of crisis, including catastrophic illness or the loss of an immediate family member. CID funds will be used to offset the cost of the golf tournament.

It's reasonable to consider that Riverside County officials would provide a summary of the intention and source of (CID) funds within County constructed documents (Form 11) for a full disclosure to County Residents. Please be advised that NO information was provided within the written Form 11 explaining (CID) funds collection and depletion propose.

It's concerning that the unique and unusual organization of Regional Access Project Foundation (RAP) was awarded another sizable portion of County (CID) disbursement funds. Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) out of Fifty Two Thousand Dollars (\$52,000.00) demonstrates an unusual pattern of county resources being directed towards one potential political element.

It's also reasonable to study fourth District Supervisors (Perez) unholy alliance between Riverside County Sheriff's Association and his desire to be elected to another Riverside County Board of Supervisor term. Any and all financial support to special Interests (Police associations/ Firefighter groups) should be recognized as potential influence endeavors of elected officials.
