**BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:**

Riverside County Workforce Development Board (WDB) is a private sector led policy and oversight body that supports the expansion and development of the regional workforce. The WDB is governed by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) which mandates that more than 50% of the WDB's members must come from the business community. In addition, WDBs are required to have representation from universities or community colleges, economic development, and local labor workforce organizations. This ensures that federal funds for workforce development activities are expended on training and career coaching that meet the needs of the business community. Pursuant to WIOA, the Board of Supervisors, led by the Board Chairman who serves as the Chief Local Elected Official (CLEO), is responsible for appointing the WDB members for two-year terms.

Adam Eventov has over two decades of media relations, public affairs, community outreach, and event management experience. He is an award-winning reporter. He was an editor for several Inland Southern California newspapers. He is actively involved in the Western Riverside County area as a government affairs manager. He is the president of the MSJC Foundation, a student of the month sponsor for Western Riverside County School Districts, and a member of the Career Technical Education advisory group.

Adam Eventov has confirmed his interest in serving on the Riverside County Workforce Development Board as a Private Sector Member for Third District. If appointed, he will serve a two-year term commencing March 5, 2026, through March 5, 2028.
