BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Greater Riverside** is a volunteer-run nonprofit dedicated to helping local students achieve their educational goals through scholarships and community support. Over the past three decades, the organization has awarded more than \$3 million to over 1,400 students, expanding access to higher education across the greater Riverside area. By mobilizing local donations and partnerships, it helps reduce financial barriers and promotes long-term economic mobility for students and their families. The \$2,500 funds requested will support the annual Scholarship Awards Event, ensuring a meaningful and well-executed celebration that honors student achievement and encourages continued academic success.
2. **City of Perris Chamber of Commerce** is a longstanding organization dedicated to promoting business success and economic prosperity through advocacy, education, and community engagement. For over a century, the Chamber has supported local businesses, especially small and minority-owned enterprises by providing resources, networking opportunities, and workforce development programs. The \$2,000 funds request will support the annual State of the City event, ensuring a high-quality platform that brings stakeholders together, highlights progress, and advances continued investment in the local economy.
3. **Riverside East Rotary Foundation** is a volunteer organization dedicated to serving the community, promoting integrity, and fostering goodwill through the leadership of local business and community members. For nearly four decades, the club has raised funds and provided both financial support and hands-on service to meet critical community needs. Its primary fundraiser, the annual Show and Go Car Show, generates significant resources that are reinvested into local programs and organizations. The \$10,000 grant requested will help expand these efforts, allowing the club to increase its impact and support more initiatives in the Greater Riverside community.
4. **Riverside Sport Hall of Fame** is a nonprofit organization dedicated to preserving and celebrating Riverside's rich athletic history while honoring individuals who have made a lasting impact through sports. Its mission is to strengthen community pride and inspire future generations by recognizing athletes, coaches, and leaders who exemplify excellence and service. The organization hosts an annual induction ceremony that brings the community together to celebrate these achievements and promote the value of athletics. The \$2,500 Grant will support the production of this event, ensuring it remains a high-quality, accessible, and meaningful experience for the Riverside community.
