**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

On November 17, 2020, the Riverside County Board of Supervisors (Board) directed the Executive Office to implement an Unincorporated Communities Initiative (UCI). The UCI is a focused, ongoing, and coordinated effort to improve the infrastructure and services provided to the residents of unincorporated communities, with emphasis on Disadvantaged Unincorporated Communities (DUCs). The program is funded through the General Fund/Net County Cost (NCC) monies from the County during the annual budget and quarterly budget revision process.

Based on the foundational work completed by the UCI Team and further analysis by the Office of Supervisor Gutierrez, \$27,005 of the remaining available UCI funding for the Fifth District will be allocated to following project:

- **\$27,005 to Valley Wide Recreation and Parks District for a resource fair event in the Fifth District.**

Since June 2024, Supervisor Gutierrez District 5 office has been sponsoring the San Jacinto Summer Bash, which is a family fun event that provides a resource fair and entertainment for constituents districtwide.

**Impact on Residents and the Community**

The Summer Bash will benefit the residents of District 5 by providing free, safe and fun entertainment for residents districtwide. Additionally, at the Summer Bash, residents in attendance will be able to access resources such as healthcare and county departments' programs and services. By providing a safe, fun, event and environment, youth and their families have a positive outlet to create lasting memories. Moreover, the events will assist the County of Riverside in bridging gaps in service, as participating residents are made aware of and connected to county resources and programs.
