

ESTABLISHING FEES, CHARGES AND RATES FOR ASSESSOR, COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER SERVICES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:  
Ordinance No. 729 is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Section 1. **PURPOSE AND SCOPE.**

A. **PURPOSE.** The purpose of this section is to establish fees in reasonable amounts to cover the costs of rendering certain enumerated services and supplies furnished by the Assessor-County Clerk-Recorder's Office.
