BACKGROUND:

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Temecula Valley Conservancy of the Arts- \$2,000-** The funds will support the Temecula Jazz 2026 Community Access and Education Initiative, a multi-day cultural program designed to remove financial barriers and provide residents with access to high-caliber live music experiences.
2. **Michelle's Place Cancer Resource Center- \$20,000-** The funds will be used to support Michelle's Place Behavioral Health Program. The program provides 150 cancer patients and their families with behavioral health counseling sessions.
3. **Nighthawk Marching Band Boosters-\$1,500-** This funding will support the band program by purchasing supplies needed to properly transport and store band equipment.
4. **Southwest Riverside County Association of Realtors-\$1,000-** This funding will be used to support the City Managers Breakfast, an event that brings together key public and private sector stakeholders to discuss issues impacting housing, economic development, and community growth.
5. **Community Youth Athletic Program - \$20,000-** The funding will be used to support the Temecula Valley Fine Art Museum & Gallery Program, which provides educational resources to youth and seniors through its rotating exhibits and workshops.

6. **The High-Country Conservancy- \$5,000-** The funds will be used to purchase a moveable stage and tent for the Anza Farmer's Markert.
7. **Temecula Valley Chamber of Commerce- \$2,800-**The funds will be used to support the 60th Annual Awards Gala, an event that honors local business owners, charitable organizations, and individuals for their exceptional contributions to the community
8. **Riverside Sheriff's Charities-\$1,500-** The funding will be utilized to support the Sheriff's Annual Awards Ceremony, an event that recognizes members of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department and volunteers for their outstanding service to the community.
