**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

Chiriaco Summit is a major hub for travelers along the I-10 Freeway between the Coachella Valley and the City of Blythe. The location is serviced by the Chiriaco Summit Water District for domestic water services. The District is also responsible for servicing fire hydrants. The hydrants provide water for structural fires as well as for Riverside County Fire Department apparatuses responding to emergencies along the I-10 Freeway. The District has informed the County of the need to replace two failing hydrants to continue emergency response availability.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

The residents of Chiriaco Summit as well as travelers along that corridor depend on the availability of the fire hydrant system for safety during emergency situations. The primary user of the hydrants is the Riverside County Fire Department. Replacing the failing fire hydrants will ensure first responders have continuous access to water when needed in an emergency.
