SUBJECT: FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT: Approval of First Amendment to Funding Agreement Between the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District and Jurupa Community Services District for the Heli-Hydrant Fire Protection System – Phase 2, Project No. 2-0-10056, CEQA Exempt per CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), District 2. [\$241,000 (Amendment) Cost – District Funds 100%]

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the First Amendment to Funding Agreement ("Amendment") is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), the "Common Sense" exemption;
2. Approve the Amendment between the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District ("District") and Jurupa Community Services District ("JCS");
3. Authorize the Chair of District's Board of Supervisors ("Board") to execute the Amendment documents on behalf of the District;
4. Authorize the District's General Manager-Chief Engineer or designee to take all necessary steps to implement the Amendment, including, but not limited to, negotiating, approving and executing any non-substantive amendments, subject to approval as to form by County Counsel; and
5. Direct the Clerk of the Board to return two fully executed original Amendment documents to the District.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

On September 10, 2024 [Agenda Item No. 11.2], the District's Board approved a Funding Agreement by which the District will contribute up to Five Hundred Thirteen Thousand Dollars (\$513,000) for the Heli-Hydrant Fire Protection System – Phase 2 ("Project") as part of a JCSD administered public works construction contract. The Project consists of the construction of Heli-Hydrant fire protection tank systems, including open water tanks connected to JCSD's water distribution system and equipped with remotely operable valving, to provide supplemental water resources for the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection ("CAL FIRE") during wildfire response in fire-prone areas within the surrounding communities of Riverside County. Said facility is to be inspected, operated and maintained by JCSD.

Subsequent to execution of the Funding Agreement, JCSD advertised the Project for public works construction bids. Based on the results of the bidding process and updated cost information, the total cost of the Project increased beyond the amount originally contemplated.

The Amendment is necessary to increase the District's financial contribution from the original amount of Five Hundred Thirteen Thousand Dollars (\$513,000) to Seven Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$754,000).

County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to legal form, and the City has executed the Amendment.

Environmental Findings

Pursuant to CEQA, the Project was reviewed and determined to be categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), the General Rule exemption. The CEQA Guidelines provide this exemption based on the general rule that CEQA only applies to projects with the potential to cause a significant effect on the environment. With certainty, there is no possibility that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment as the Project is merely an amendment between public agencies to provide additional funding to implement the Project.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO FUNDING AGREEMENT

Heli Hydrant Fire Protection System – Phase 2
Project No. 2-0-10056

This First Amendment to Funding Agreement ("First Amendment"), dated as of MAY 0 5 2026, is entered into by and between the RIVERSIDE COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, a body corporate and politic ("DISTRICT"), and the JURUPA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT, an independent special district of the State of California ("JCSD"). DISTRICT and JCSD are collectively referred to herein as "Parties" and individually as "Party". The Parties hereby agree as follows:

RECITALS

A. DISTRICT and JCSD have entered into that certain Funding Agreement dated September 10, 2024 [DISTRICT's Board Agenda Item No. 11.2], hereinafter called "Original Agreement", for the construction of the Heli-Hydrant Fire Protection System – Phase 2 ("PROJECT"), which consists of open water tanks connected to JCSD's water distribution system and equipped with remotely operable valving to provide supplemental water resources for wildfire response in fire-prone areas within the surrounding communities of Riverside County.

B. Pursuant to Original Agreement, DISTRICT desired to contribute a total amount not to exceed Five Hundred Thirteen Thousand Dollars (\$513,000) to JCSD toward JCSD's construction of PROJECT.

C. Subsequent to the execution of Original Agreement, JCSD advertised PROJECT for public works construction bids, and based on the results of the bidding process and updated cost information, the total cost of PROJECT increased from an estimated Five Hundred Thirteen Thousand Dollars (\$513,000) to Seven Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$754,000).

D. Original Agreement together with the First Amendment are collectively referred to herein as "AGREEMENT".

E. Section III.11 of the Original Agreement specifies that it may be changed or modified subject to the written consent of the Parties thereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the preceding recitals and the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the Parties hereto mutually agree to amend AGREEMENT as follows:

1. Last sentence in RECITALS E of AGREEMENT is hereby amended to read:

"CONSTRUCTION CONTRIBUTION for PROJECT shall not exceed a total of Seven Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$754,000)."

2. First sentence in SECTION I.5 of AGREEMENT is hereby amended to read:

"At the time of providing written notice of the award of a construction contract for PROJECT, invoice DISTRICT (Attention: Special Projects Section) for CONSTRUCTION CONTRIBUTION, subject to and provided that, CONSTRUCTION CONTRIBUTION does not exceed a total sum of Seven Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$754,000) for PROJECT."

3. SECTION II.1 of AGREEMENT is hereby amended to read:

"Within thirty (30) days after receipt of JCSD's invoices (i) pay all approved JCSD invoices and (ii) review and approve associated documents as described in RECITALS and SECTION I herein this Agreement, subject to and provided that CONSTRUCTION

CONTRIBUTION shall not exceed, Seven Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$754,000) for PROJECT."

4. First sentence of SECTION III.1 of AGREEMENT is hereby amended to read:

"Notwithstanding any other provision herein this Agreement, CONSTRUCTION CONTRIBUTION shall not exceed a total sum of Seven Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$754,000) and shall be used by JCSD solely for the purpose of constructing PROJECT as set forth herein."

5. Except to the extent specifically deleted, added to, or amended herein, all of the terms, covenants and conditions of said Original Agreement executed on September 10, 2024, shall remain in full force and effect between Parties hereto.

6. This First Amendment shall not be binding or consummated until its approval by DISTRICT's Board of Supervisors and fully executed by Parties.

7. This First Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which will be an original but all of which together will constitute one instrument. Each Party of this First Amendment agrees to the use of electronic signatures, such as digital signatures that meet the requirements of the California Uniform Electronic Transactions Act ("CUETA") Cal. Civ. Code §§ 1633.1 to 1633.17), for executing this First Amendment. The Parties further agree that the electronic signatures of the Parties included in this First Amendment are intended to authenticate this writing and to have the same force and effect as manual signatures. Electronic signature means an electronic sound, symbol or process attached to or logically associated with an electronic record and executed or adopted by a person with the intent to sign the electronic record pursuant to CUETA as amended from time to time. CUETA authorizes use of an electronic signature for transactions and contracts among Parties in California, including a government

agency. Digital signature means an electronic identifier, created by computer, intended by the Party using it to have the same force and effect as the use of a manual signature and shall be reasonably relied upon by the Parties. For purposes of this section, a digital signature is a type of "electronic signature" as defined in subdivision (i) of Section 1633.2 of the Civil Code.

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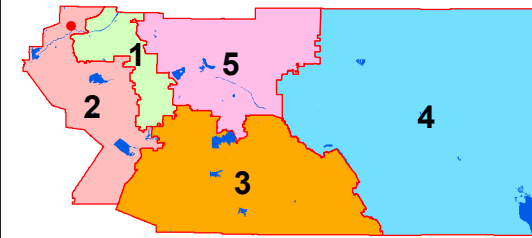

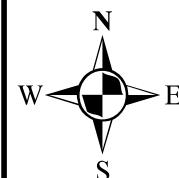

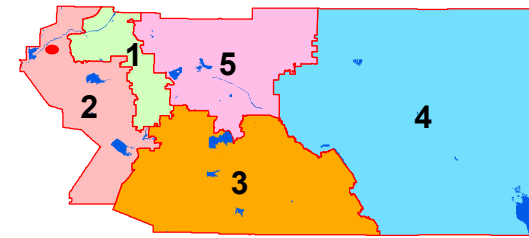
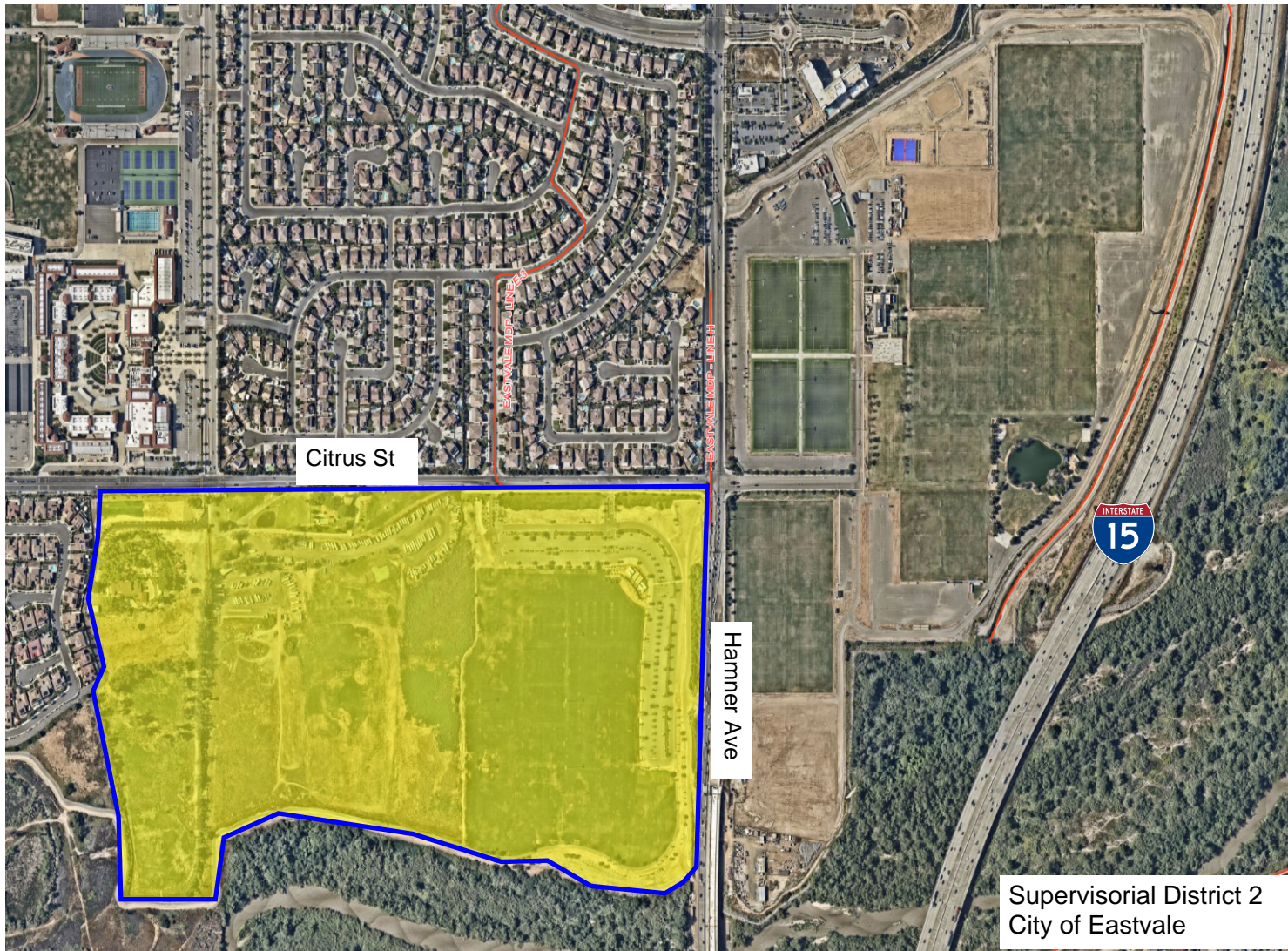
