

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Riverside Chamber of Commerce** is dedicated to strengthening the local economy by supporting businesses and advocating community interests. The \$1,750 will fund scholarships for outstanding young women attending California Baptist University, La Sierra University, Riverside Community College District, and the University of California, Riverside. The event will be held on May 28, 2026, at 11:30 a.m. at the Victoria Club, 2521 Arroyo Drive, Riverside, CA 92506.

2. **Riverside County Department of Animal Services**, in partnership with the County Supervisor Jose Medina, will host a spay and neuter clinic event for pets belonging to residents within the First District. This initiative aims to promote responsible pet ownership and reduce pet overpopulation. The \$3,500.00 will provide accessible service to the residents.

3. **The Riverside National Cemetery Support Committee**, established in 1996, supports the maintenance, operations, and commemorative activities of Riverside National Cemetery. The \$5,000 grant request will support the annual Concert for Heroes, a free patriotic event honoring veterans and their families. Funds will cover essential event costs, including musicians, audio/visual equipment, and event logistics. The concert brings together thousands of community members each year to celebrate and recognize the service and sacrifice of military personnel.
