**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District ("District") utilizes fence trucks for the installation, repair and maintenance of fencing along District infrastructure, facilities and properties. The fence buildouts are important because they enable quick, efficient fence repairs and installations, helping to maintain public safety and secure infrastructure. Furthermore, specialized equipment like welding equipment, generators, tool racks and onboard storage allows crews to perform this work effectively in the field.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

Costs incurred will be funded by ad valorem property tax revenue and create no new fees, taxes or bonded indebtedness.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

Sufficient funding is available in the District's budget for Fiscal Year 2025/2026 and was included in the recommended budget for Fiscal Year 2026/2027 as appropriate and necessary.

**Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

On March 11, 2026, the District released a Request for Quote (RFQ) FCARC-00200 soliciting quotes for the buildout of three F-550 cabs and chassis with specified fence truck body. The District advertised in three newspapers and on the District website. Three bids were received in response to the RFQ and were reviewed by District staff for cost analysis. The quotations received ranged in cost from \$300,564 to \$490,941.

Based on the overall summation of the quotations submitted, it is the recommendation of the District to award Pacific Trucks Equipment, Inc. as the lowest-priced and most responsive bidder for this service.
