All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, June 24, 2026, at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk and State Clearinghouse for posting within five (5) working days.



**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to reconstruct an approximately 0.8 miles segment of Dillon Road from 200 feet West of Louise Street to Little Morongo Road in the Community of North Palm Springs in Riverside County.

Dillon Road is classified as an Arterial Highway that travels in the East-West direction. Within the project limits, Dillon Road is a two-lane road that varies between 32 feet to 64 feet in width. The area within the immediate project vicinity consists primarily of vacant land, a solar facility, and a limited number of private businesses.

Roadway reconstruction is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions, generally associated with age and thermal effects. The proposed reconstruction project consists of removing the existing asphalt and underlying material and placing back new Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA).

Additional improvements include clear and re-grade existing dirt flow lines to improve drainage, concrete cross-gutter construction, placement of safety edge to protect the outside edge of pavement, and utility adjustments. Safety features include placing of thermoplastic crosswalk and pavement marking, roadside signs, and other associated work.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

- Base Bid Schedule: Dillon Road Reconstruction
- Alternative Bid 1: City of Desert Hot Springs Portion
- Alternative Bid 2: Mission Springs Water District (MSWD) Facilities Adjustments

Improvements within the City of Desert Hot Springs are included in the bid package as an alternate bid schedule. If City of Desert Hot Springs approves the award of their alternate bid schedule, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by the City of Desert Hot Springs through a reimbursement Agreement, which will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval prior to or concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

The adjustment of the facilities owned by MSWD, are also included in the bid package as an alternative bid schedule. If MSWD approve the award of their alternative bid schedule, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by the utility owner through a reimbursement letter Agreement that will be executed by the Director of Transportation. The Director of Transportation has the authority to sign reimbursement Agreements up to \$100,000 per Minute Order dated November 19, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.25).

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid for the sum of all bid schedules.

**Environmental Findings**

The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because the Dillion Road Reconstruction project does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt for the approximately 0.8 miles segment of Dillon Road to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in summer 2026. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

**SUPPLEMENTAL:**

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,663,069. The County improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. The City of Desert Hot Springs and MSWD are responsible for funding their respective alternative bid schedules in full if approved.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

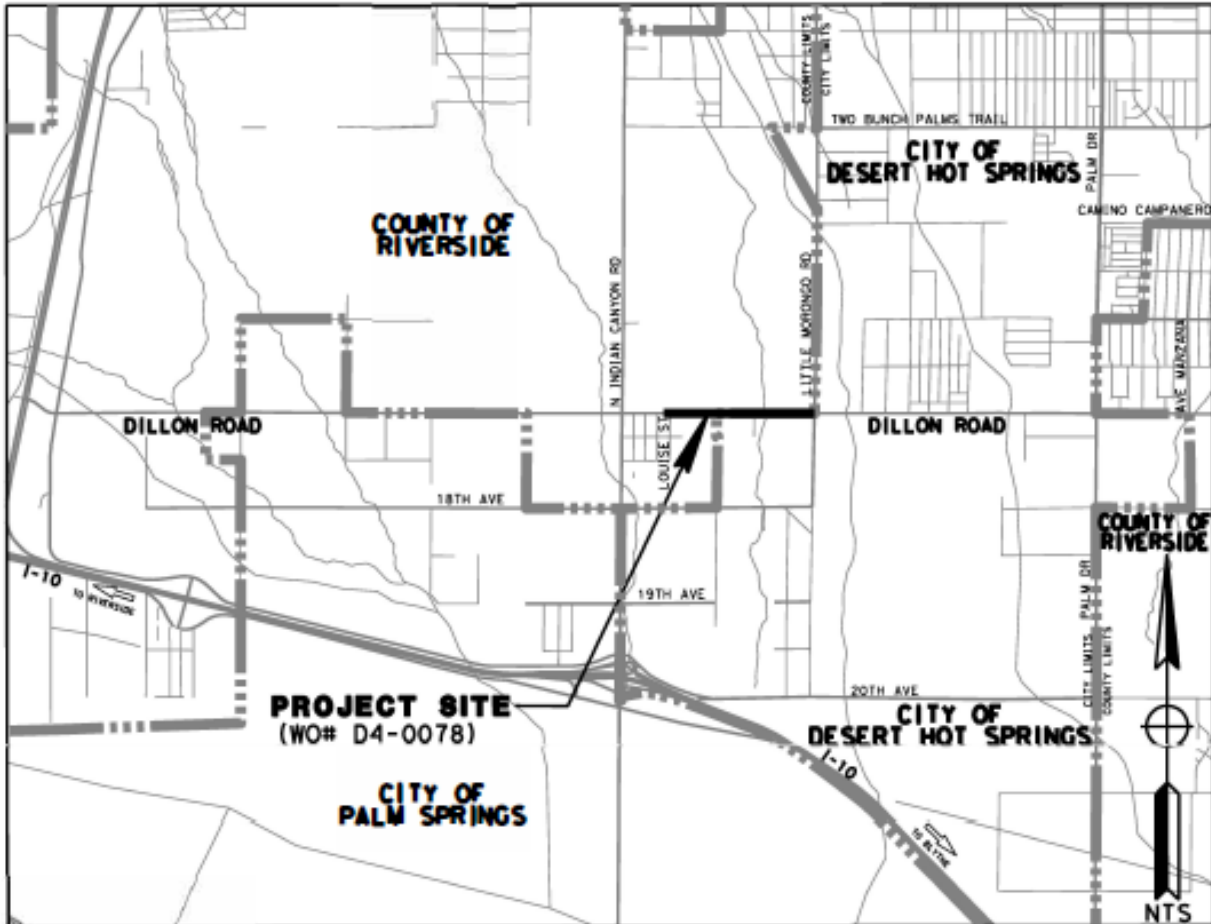
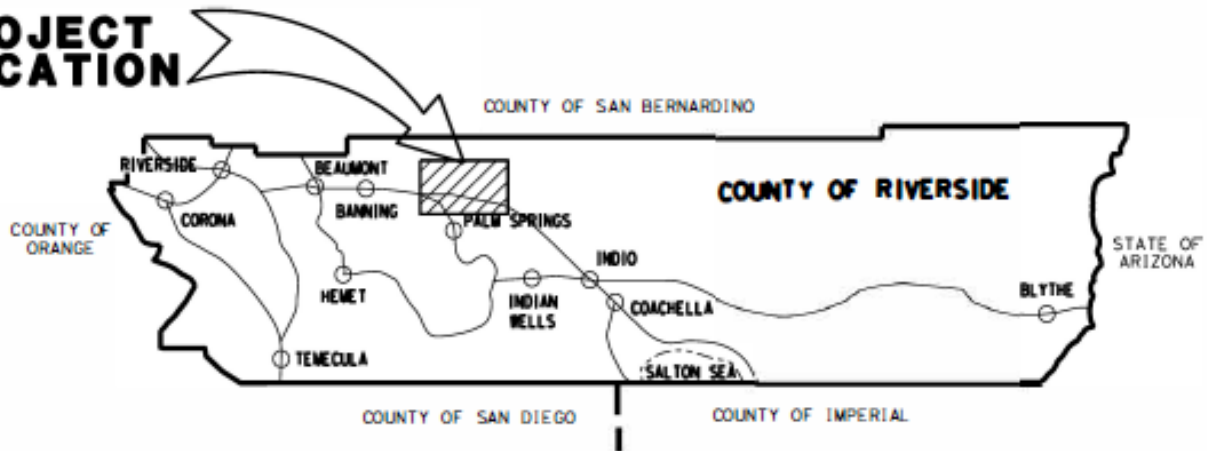

**ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:**

The proposed project improvements do not require additional right-of-way or temporary construction easements.

This proposed project is subject to compliance with the Coachella Valley Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (CVMSHCP). In accordance with the CVMSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside/inside of cell criteria area/conservation areas. This project is considered to be operation and maintenance; therefore, it is a covered activity under the CVMSHCP.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the typical migratory bird breeding season (February 1 – August 31), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act of 1918 and California Fish and Game Codes Section 3500, 3503, 3503.5, 3513, and 3800.

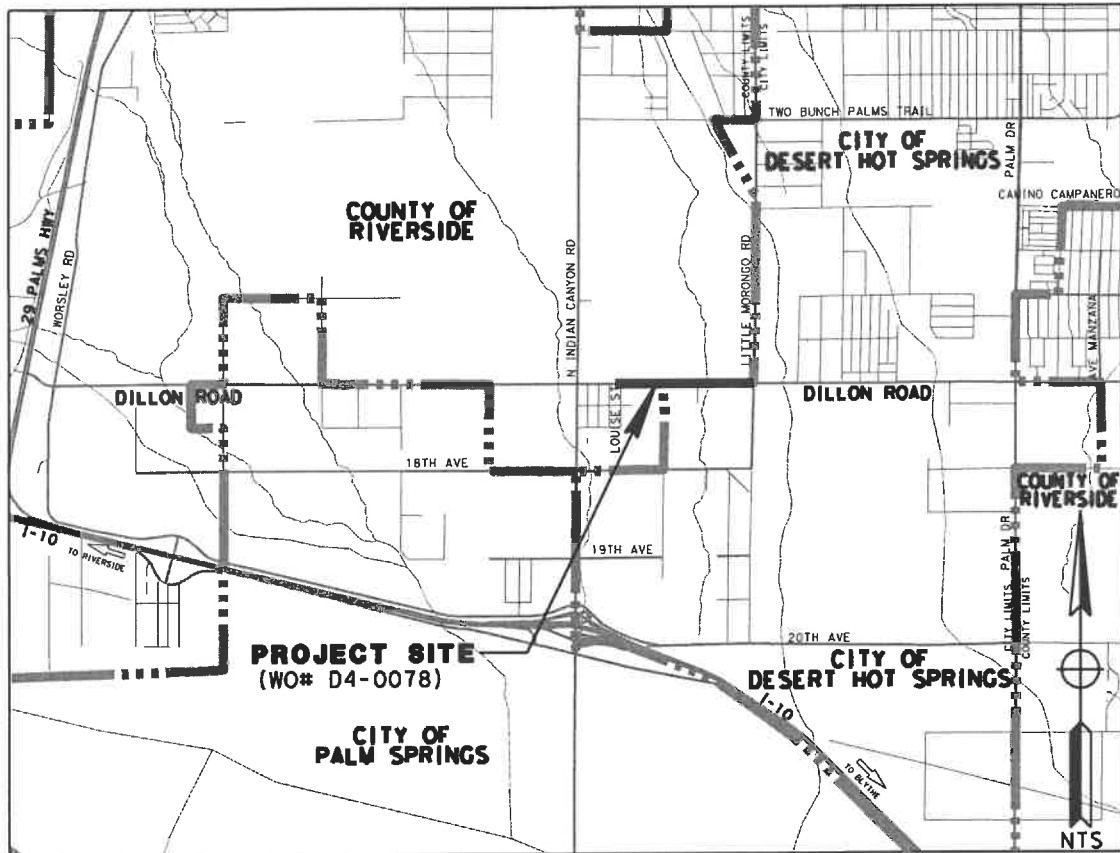
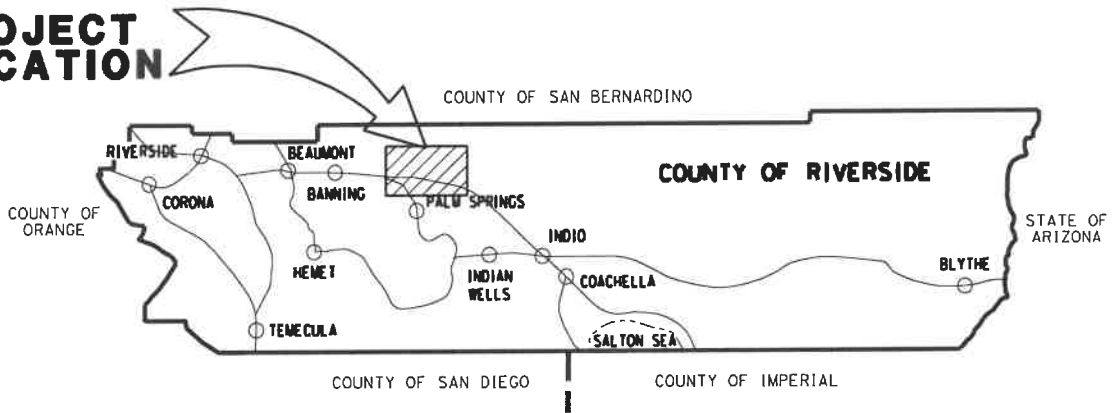


