

**BACKGROUND:**

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Oak Grove Institute Foundation- \$3,250-**The funds will support “Rock the Oaks” and “Evening Under the Oaks,” two fundraising events that benefit Oak Grove Center’s specialized programs, which help youth overcome abuse, neglect, mental health challenges, and learning disabilities.
2. **Boys & Girls Club of Southwest County- \$10,000-** The funds will support the Boys & Girls Club of Southwest County’s Summer Day Camp, an annual program in which approximately 350 youth ages 6–17 participate in developmental activities that enhance their critical thinking, social, and emotional intelligence skills.
3. **Rotary Club of Temecula-\$5,000-** The funding will support the Holiday Food Basket Program, which serves low-income families within the Temecula Valley Unified School District by providing food assistance during the holiday season.
4. **City of Temecula-\$10,000-** The funding will support Care Solace, a program that provides mental health and healthcare support to individuals and families who may be experiencing homelessness.
5. **Riverside County Child Support Services-\$1,000-** The funding will support the Child Support Awareness Month – Acts of Support Program, including the

backpack and school supply giveaway designed to assist children and families throughout District 3 during the back-to-school season.

6. **Green Acres Interactive Therapy Inc.-\$1,750-** The funding will support the Fire Families BBQ and Ranch Day, an event that raises funds for the GAIT program, which provides therapeutic horse therapy to firefighters experiencing mental health challenges or PTSD.
7. **Menifee VFW Post 1956- \$5,000-** The funds will be used to help veterans with unforeseen unmet needs such as medical and dental co-payments.
8. **Murrieta Chamber of Commerce- \$1,500-** Th funds will be used to support the 66<sup>th</sup> Annual Awards, an event that recognizes and supports exceptional businesses that demonstrated strong community involvement in the Southwest Riverside County Area.
