

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Riverside County Advisory Council on Aging (“Council”) is the local Area Advisory Council on Aging, mandated by the Federal Older Americans Act and the State Older Californians Act. The Council is a volunteer leadership body whose purpose is to advise the Riverside County Office on Aging (RCOoA) and the Riverside County Board of Supervisors on all matters related to older adults, the development of RCOoA’s Area Plan on Aging (“Area Plan”), the administration of the Area Plan, and operations conducted under the Area Plan. Pursuant to the Council’s bylaws, Council membership shall consist of seventeen (17) members and be composed of: (1) a majority of persons sixty (60) years of age or older; (2) members who reflect the districts established by the county’s Board of Supervisors as well as the geographic diversity and racial, ethnic, economic, and social demographics of the planning and service area; (3) individuals who fall within key representation categories as defined by Title III of the Older Americans Act; and (4) the Director of the Office on Aging, or his/her designee, who shall serve as an ex officio member. Each member shall be a resident of Riverside County or be employed within the county.

Tyler Cobb of Menifee, and Teresa Chappell of San Jacinto, are current Advisory Council members-at-large serving their second and third consecutive terms respectively. After submitting member evaluation forms, the Advisory Council has voted to accept their reappointment, as these members are at the end of their three-year terms. Michael Levitt of Beaumont was appointed as a member-at-large to fill a vacant seat with less than half of the prior member’s seat term remaining. Per the Advisory Council Bylaws, Mr. Levitt is eligible for an automatic reappointment to a three-year term, contingent on approval by the Riverside County Board of Supervisors.

In accordance with Board Policy A-21, Resolution No. 2005-148, Uniform Rules and Procedures for Advisory Committees, Boards and Commissions of the County of Riverside, and the Council’s bylaws, the RCOoA, and the Advisory Council on Aging recommend and respectfully request the Board of Supervisors re-appoint Teresa Chappell, Tyler Cobb, and Michael Levitt to the Riverside County Advisory Council on Aging for three-year terms beginning July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2029.
