BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to ten (4) High School graduates, who served on the Second District Youth Advisory Council (YAC):

1. This scholarship will support Second District YAC members for their hard work and dedication to their community during their council year(s) and assist in pursuing their education.
2. Eligibility considerations are as follows:
 - a. Must be a graduating senior attending a community college, public/private college, or university, or an eligible trade school.
 - b. Total number of community service hours that were contributed to the council.
 - c. Total number of years that the student has served on the Second District Youth Advisory Council (Up to \$500 per year served).
 - d. YAC members must provide an essay demonstrating the knowledge they have learned while participating in the Youth Commission/Youth Advisory Council, how they have impacted their community, leadership experiences, and future career aspirations.
 - e. Must provide acceptance letter and provisional transcript.
