**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Riverside Sheriffs' Association (RSA) is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$1,500. Funding will support the 2026 Riverside Sheriffs' Association Awards Banquet, an annual event recognizing outstanding public safety professionals for their service, leadership, and contributions to Riverside County communities. The event honors law enforcement personnel and strengthens community support for public safety initiatives throughout the region.
  
- 2. Riverside Sheriff's Charities is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$1,000. Funding will support the 2026 Sheriff's Annual Awards Ceremony, an annual event recognizing sworn and non-sworn Sheriff's personnel, volunteers, and community members for outstanding service, courage, and contributions to Riverside County communities.
  
- 3. Moreno Valley PONY Baseball and Softball is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$5,000. Funding will support youth baseball and softball programming in Moreno Valley by helping offset participation costs for families experiencing financial hardship, ensuring local youth continue to have access to organized sports opportunities. The league serves approximately 1,000 players each season and has provided recreational sports programs to Moreno Valley youth since 1968.

4. Pacific Crest Youth Arts Organization is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$10,000. Funding will support ongoing youth arts programming that provides educational, performance, and leadership opportunities for participating students.
5. Moreno Christian Assembly is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$2,500. Funding will support the organization's annual Harvest Festival, a free family-friendly community event serving residents of Moreno Valley and the surrounding Fifth District communities. The event provides a safe recreational environment featuring games, activities, entertainment, and community engagement opportunities for local families.
6. Beaumont Cherry Valley Recreation and Park Improvement Corporation is receiving Community Improvement Designation Funds (CID) in the amount of \$15,000 to establish a permanent, ADA-compliant American flag retirement site at the Cherry Valley Grange, supporting veterans and community groups through ceremonial and educational use.
