

BACKGROUND:

Summary

This Board item requests approval of the agreement amendments listed for the identified contractors for a revised term ending June 30, 2029, and increases the aggregate annual compensation for the Department of Purchasing & Fleet Services (P&F) towing services program. The requested amendments will help ensure continued operational coverage and maintain the Department's ability to respond to routine and emergency towing and recovery needs across Riverside County.

These amendments apply only to the Purchasing & Fleet Services business unit, as the original agreements were awarded through a competitive multi-agency solicitation process. One of the original awardees, Life Saver Towing, Inc., has since ceased operations and is no longer available to service its designated agreement area. Due to increased demand for towing services, the operational need to maintain adequate geographic coverage, and the loss of Life Saver Towing, Inc., P&F requires increased annual contract authority, resulting in a revised aggregate compensation amount of up to \$2,454,574, inclusive of contingency.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The towing service contractors support the operational capacity of the Department's Fleet Services Division by providing reliable, on-demand towing and recovery services, including emergency roadside assistance for County-owned vehicles. These services help minimize vehicle downtime and ensure fleet assets remain available to support essential County operations. The availability of responsive towing and recovery services is critical to supporting departments that provide direct services to residents and businesses throughout Riverside County.

Additional Fiscal Information

The original period of performance for all referenced agreements was from approximately February 2025 to November 30, 2029. In addition to increasing funds, the amendments will

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revise the term to a fiscal year basis and update the annual period of performance to end on June 30 of each year, to align with the fiscal year calendar.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

On August 12, 2024, Riverside County Purchasing, on behalf of County Fleet Services, the Sheriff's Department, the Fire Department, and the Transportation and Land Management Agency, issued Request for Quote (RFQ) PUARC-1727 for towing services. This solicitation was publicly posted on Public Purchase and distributed to multiple vendors to maximize competition and encourage broad vendor participation. On August 28, 2024, the solicitation closed with seven (7) responses received.

Following evaluation of proposed rates, service zone coverage, equipment capacity, response capabilities, and licensing requirements, it was determined that awarding contracts to all seven (7) vendors was in the County's best interest to ensure sufficient towing and recovery coverage across participating departments and geographic service areas. Awards supporting County Fleet Services were issued to G Brown Corp. dba Town & Country Towing (which has since been assigned to J&G Group Partners LLC dba Town & Country Towing), Mark D. Henley dba Complete Towing & Recovery, B.C. Ventures, Inc. dba Classic Auto Transport (which has since been assigned to R & W Enterprises, Inc. dba Classic Auto Transport), Limor Enterprises, Inc. dba Auto Aide Towing, Stagecoach Towing, Inc., Statewide Road Solutions, LLC, and Life Saver Towing, Inc. (who has since ceased operations).

On January 28, 2025, via Agenda Item No. 3.20, the Board of Supervisors approved the Agreements for Vehicle Towing Services. Amendments requested do not include changes to any service rates, they only increase capacity of the existing agreements to maintain continuity of services and support ongoing operational needs. The proposed amendment amounts remain reasonable based on the original competitive solicitation process and current operational trends.

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR now desire to amend the Agreement to revise the end date of the period of performance and increase the annual maximum contract amount;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

"This Agreement shall be effective upon signature of this Agreement by both parties and continues in effect through June 30, 2029, unless terminated earlier."

3. **Compensation.** The third sentence of Subsection 3.1 of Section 3. Compensation of the Agreement is hereby amended to increase the annual maximum contract amount by \$7,571, from \$42,429 annually to \$50,000 annually, as follows:

"The maximum amount payable by COUNTY to CONTRACTOR, for towing services rendered to Purchasing and Fleet Services, shall not exceed forty-two thousand four hundred twenty-nine dollars (\$42,429) for COUNTY Fiscal Year 24/25 (February 11, 2025 – June 30, 2025) and fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) per COUNTY Fiscal Year for COUNTY Fiscal Year 25/26 (July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026), COUNTY Fiscal Year 26/27 (July 1, 2026 – June 30, 2027), COUNTY Fiscal Year 27/28 (July 1, 2027 – June 30, 2028), and COUNTY Fiscal Year 28/29 (July 1, 2028 – June 30, 2029), including all expenses."

4. **Miscellaneous.** All other terms and conditions of the Agreement not modified herein shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
5. **Effective Date.** This Amendment No. 1 shall be effective upon signature of this Amendment No. 1 by both parties.
6. **Counterparts; Electronic Signatures.** This Amendment No. 1 may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which will be an original, but all of which together will constitute one instrument. Each party to this Amendment No. 1 agrees to the use of electronic signatures, such as digital signatures that meet the requirements of the California Uniform Electronic Transactions Act (“CUETA”) Cal. Civ. Code §§ 1633.1 to 1633.17), for executing this Amendment No. 1. The parties further agree that the electronic signatures of the parties included in this Amendment No. 1 are intended to authenticate this writing and to have the same force and effect as manual signatures. Electronic signature means an electronic sound, symbol, or process attached to or logically associated with an electronic record and executed or adopted by a person with the intent to sign the electronic record pursuant to the CUETA as amended from time to time. The CUETA authorizes use of an electronic signature for transactions and contracts among parties in California, including a government agency. Digital signature means an electronic identifier, created by computer, intended by the party using it to have the same force and effect as the use of a manual signature, and shall be reasonably relied upon by the parties. For purposes of this section, a digital signature is a type of "electronic signature" as defined in subdivision (i) of Section 1633.2 of the Civil Code.
