4. Approve the project's proposed budget as shown in Attachment "A".



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated March 24, 2026 (Agenda Item 3.41), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Trash Capture Device Installation Project in various locations within the County of Riverside.

In general, this project consists of the installation of Full Trash Capture Devices (FTCD) known as Connector Pipe Screens (CPS) in various existing storm drain inlet structures located in identified significant trash generating areas of the Santa Margarita, Santa Ana, and Whitewater Watersheds within the County of Riverside jurisdiction, in order to comply with the California mandated Trash Provisions.

A FTCD - CPS consists of a metal screen assembly installed inside a catch basin in front of the entrance to a connector pipe that prevents trash from entering the storm drain system.

A total of 249 FTCD - CPS are proposed to be installed:

- 138 in the Santa Ana Watershed,
- 77 in the Whitewater Watershed, and
- 34 in the Santa Margarita Watershed.

Rainstorms wash trash into gutters and storm drains which eventually lead into streams, creeks, rivers, and the ocean. Cigarette butts, paper, fast food containers, plastic bags, cans and bottles, are just a few examples of the different types of trash produced by human activity that continue to pollute waterways. Trash is a significant pollutant to California's waterways that cause adverse effects to aquatic life, wildlife, and public health.

The Trash Provisions were adopted by the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) on April 7, 2015. The Trash Provisions were approved by the California Office of Administrative Law on December 2, 2015, and approved by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency on January 12, 2016.

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STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

These regulations were designed to eliminate trash pollution from stormwater systems statewide, protecting rivers, creeks, and coastal waters from debris that harm wildlife, clogs drainage systems, and impacts water quality.

The California Trash Provisions require public agencies to take measures to prevent trash larger than 5 millimeters (approximately 3/16-inch, which is about the size of a cigarette butt) from entering storm drains and waterways by 2030.

The Contract includes the following schedule of work:

Base Bid Schedule: Full Trash Capture Device – Connector Pipe Screen Installation

The contractor, United Storm Water, Inc., is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the Bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the contract documents.

Project No. D6-0061

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The project proposes installing trash capture devices known as connector pipe screens in existing storm water drainage inlet facilities located within the County of Riverside right-of-way to eliminate trash pollution from stormwater systems, protecting rivers, creeks, and coastal waters from debris that harm wildlife, clog drainage systems, and impact water quality.

The work is scheduled to begin in summer 2026. The work will be phased to keep the roads open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately four months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in Fiscal Year 2026/2027 and will be funded with Gas Tax / HUTA local funds.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

A total of three bids were received on Wednesday April 15, 2026, ranging from \$480,950 to \$1,663,940. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The low bidder, United Storm Water, Inc., submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid in the amount of \$480,950 which is \$1,168,050 (70.8%) below the engineer's cost estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to United Storm Water, Inc. in the amount of \$480,950.

Contract

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **United Storm Water, Inc.**, hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

Recitals:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Trash Capture Device Installation, Various Locations in Riverside County, Throughout the Santa Margarita, Santa Ana, and Whitewater Watersheds, Project No. D6-0061**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders, (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of **2018** as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda (**None**), (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.04, "Start of Job Site Activities", Section 8-1.05, "Time", and in Section 8-1.10 "Liquidated Damages" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within fifteen (15) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

United shall provide all materials, labor, and equipment required to install a total of approximately (249) CPS devices within City owned catch basins. Services include traffic control, pre-installation cleaning of the catch basins to be retrofitted, and documentation to include before and after photos and an installation report. Disposal of the extracted waste from pre-installation cleaning and painting of staff gauges within the retrofitted catch basins is also included in the scope of work.

All miscellaneous/extra work (e.g., manhole installation, catch basin repairs of any kind, catch basin floor slope correction, etc.) will all be handled under bid line item 3, Miscellaneous Work. If miscellaneous work is requested by the County, United will provide a quote for County consideration using Caltrans force account rates.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations and prevailing wage rates apply.

For this project United Storm Water proposes installation of its own CPS devices. United Storm Water's CPS devices have been approved by the Water Board, and the Mosquito and Vector Control Association of California (MVCAC). Product names are provided below:

- USW-1M1 Removable Screen With Swivel Plate Access
- USW-1M2 Removable Screen With Hinged Deflector
- USW-2M1 Fixed Screen With Swivel Plate Access
- USW-2M2 Fixed Screen With Hinged Deflector

Design options include mosquito abatement features having removable or fixed front screen panels. The USW-1M1 and USW-1M2 models have removable front screen panels that are best suited *for shallow catch basin applications*. The USW-2M1 and USW-2M2 models have fixed front screen panels that are best suited for deeper catch basins and or larger inlet/outlet pipe diameters. **Technical Drawings** of all models are provided as **Exhibit 1**.

All CPS devices will be custom fitted onsite. The bottom of the front panel will also be scribed and cut to conform to the shape of the catch basin floor. Should an outlet pipe be located within close proximity to a corner of the catch basin to be retrofitted a triangular shaped CPS device will be installed as depicted here.



All models allow for visual access and treatment of mosquitos by vector control district staff via the swivel access plate or hinged deflector access. Individual catch basin configurations will determine if USW-1M1/USW-2M1 (swivel access plate) or USW-1M2/USW-2M2 (hinged deflector) configurations will be the best design regarding accessibility for mosquito abatement activities. The swivel access plate models are used when there is not adequate clearance for a hinged deflector to open fully.


For liability and public safety reasons United Storm Water will have the final determination as to which model of CPS device will be best suited for each catch basin to be retrofitted.

Drawings included in the bid specifications are not entirely in line with United Storm Water's Water Board approved CPS devices. Only United Storm Water's Water Board approved CPS designs will be considered for installation despite any design variations that the County may have included in the bid specifications.

Should a CPS device not be suitable for any catch basin to be retrofitted based on catch basin measurements or nonconforming conditions (e.g. sump type drain), alternate full trash capture device types (other than CPS) from United or other manufacturers will be recommended to the County for those catch basins in question, which may trigger a change order as agreed to by both parties in writing. Alternatively, the County may also provide United with alternate installation locations when installation of a CPS device at any of the locations identified for retrofit is not feasible.

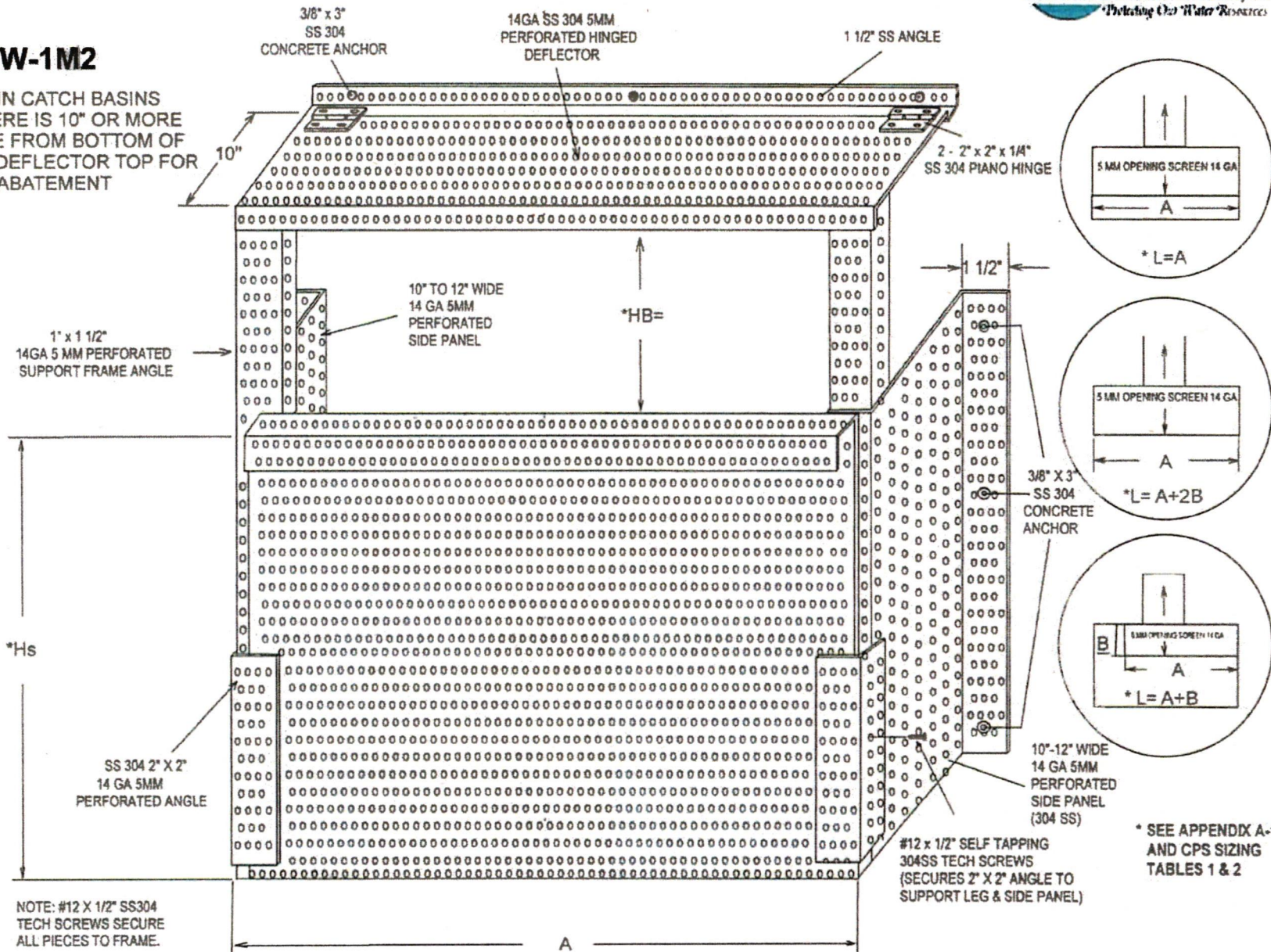
