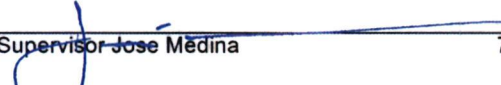

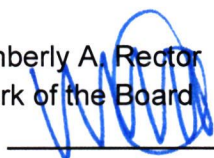

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The NAACP Riverside County Youth Council is a youth-led civil rights organization that empowers young people through leadership development, civic engagement, advocacy, and community service. The requested \$5,000 grant will help remove financial barriers for members to attend the 117th NAACP National Convention, where they will receive leadership, legal advocacy, and civic engagement training. Participants will bring the knowledge and skills gained back to Riverside County to strengthen local youth leadership, advocacy efforts, and community involvement.
2. The Perris Valley Chamber of Commerce has supported local businesses and economic development in the Perris Valley since 1912 through advocacy, education, networking, and community leadership. The \$1,000 grant requested will support the 113th Annual Installation & Awards Gala, which recognizes outstanding businesses, volunteers, nonprofit organizations, and community leaders for their contributions to the region. The event fosters collaboration, celebrates civic achievement, and strengthens relationships that contribute to the continued success and prosperity of the Perris Valley community.
3. Riverside County Department of Child Support Services (RivCoDCSS) has served local families for more than 25 years by providing child support services, connecting residents to community resources, and promoting family stability and self-sufficiency. The requested \$2,500 funding will support the Child Support Awareness Month Backpack & School Supply Giveaway on August 8, 2026, as well as District 1 "Acts of Support" outreach activities that provide school supplies, resource information, and family assistance.
