BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Lift to Rise is a collective impact organization that works to achieve a future where all Coachella Valley families are healthy, stable and thriving. The long-term outcome of their work seeks to achieve is reducing the number of residents at a population level that are experiencing rent burden by 30% by the year 2028. Lift to Rise hosted the third annual Community Investment Awards on March 7, 2026, at the Palm Springs Air Museum to recognize local community leaders and celebrate the collective progress in our region. CID funds will be utilized for community engagement efforts, including marketing and advertising costs.
2. The Palm Springs Friends of Philharmonic (PS Phil) commits to enriching the cultural life of the Coachella Valley by presenting world-class orchestras and extraordinary classical music performances. PS Phil hosted a Latin music festival on January 25, 2026, with the Minería Symphony Orchestra of Mexico at the Cathedral City Amphitheater. This celebration of music and dance was hosted at no cost to the families and residents of the Coachella Valley. CID funds will be utilized for the expenses of producing this event.
3. Riverside County DPSS is dedicated to supporting and improving the health, safety, independence, and well-being of individuals and families. DPSS hosted the 2026 Elder and Dependent Adult Abuse Symposium at the Riverside Convention Center on June 25, 2026. This event raised awareness about elder and dependent adult abuse and highlighted innovative approaches, programs, and strategies that aim to prevent and protect the elder or dependent adult from abuse and neglect. CID funds will be utilized to cover the expenses of equipment for the training and breakout sessions.
4. Seiden-Juku provides specialized Para-Karate training for individuals with autism, Down syndrome, cerebral palsy, visual impairments, and wheelchair athletes. Through Seiden-Juku's Bushido Warriors Program, athletes receive adaptive instruction rooted in the principles of Bushido, helping them build confidence, discipline, emotional regulation, respect, resilience, and self-worth. Each athlete receives individualized support based on their unique needs, ensuring safety, dignity, and meaningful progress. CID funds will be used to help cover the cost of belt examinations and belt ceremonies for 12 children enrolled in Seiden-Juku's Bushido Warriors Program.
