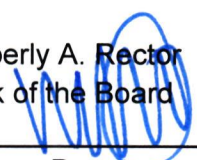

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The City of La Quinta approved the First Amendment to the Law Enforcement Services Agreement for a modification of the level of service for FY25/26 through FY26/27. This First Amendment to the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services with the City of La Quinta modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Office with the deletion of four (4) Deputy Sheriff- eight-four (84) positions.

The FY26/27 estimated law enforcement cost is \$19,287,000. The Sheriff's Office has included the cost estimate in its budget; therefore, no budget adjustment is necessary. County Counsel has approved the First Amendment as to form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This is a First Amendment to the Agreement between the City of La Quinta and the Sheriff's Office for law enforcement services, which the City of La Quinta approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through the Sheriff's Board-approved rates.

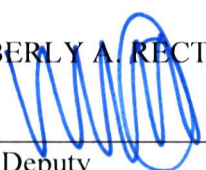

FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT
SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF LA QUINTA
AND THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of the Riverside County Sheriff's Office, and the City of La Quinta, a California Charter City, approved by the Board of Supervisors on June 24, 2025 in Minute Order 3.49 for services effective July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2027, is hereby amended in the following respects, and all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect:

1. Attachment A of the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with Attachment A-1, attached hereto to this First Amendment and incorporated herein by this reference.
2. Effective Date. This First Amendment shall become effective upon last signature of the parties.
