SUBJECT: REGIONAL PARK AND OPEN-SPACE DISTRICT: Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District – Approve the Loan Agreement for the Public Art Display of “Monarchs by HANNAH” with GOLDENVOICE, LLC in the amount of \$198,880; District 4. [Total Cost \$180,800; up to \$18,080 in additional compensation; 100% Park Acq & Dev, District Fund 33100]

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Directors:

1. Ratify and Approve the Loan Agreement for the Public Art Display of “Monarchs by HANNAH” with GOLDENVOICE, LLC without seeking competitive bids for a period of ten (10) years from November 3, 2025 through November 3, 2035;
2. Authorize the Chairman to execute two (2) copies of the Loan Agreement on behalf of the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District (“District”);
3. Direct the Purchasing Agent to issue Purchase Orders to GOLDENVOICE, LLC for the duration of the Loan Agreement that do not exceed the total contract amount of \$180,800 included up to \$18,080 in additional compensation; for a total not to exceed amount of \$198,880;
4. Authorize the General Manager, or their Designee, to execute future amendments to the Loan Agreement that exercise the options in the Loan Agreement, including amendments that extend the Loan Agreement for a period not to exceed ten (10) years for a compensation amount not to exceed \$200,000 for the ten year term, subject to the availability of fiscal funding, and approved as to form by County Counsel; and
5. Direct the Clerk of the Board to return one (1) copy of the executed Loan Agreement to the District.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District ("District") seeks to enhance public spaces and serve the general welfare through the long-term display of high-quality artwork. The piece, "Monarchs by HANNAH " features four towers and furniture. The towers are made from a combination of 3D-printed concrete bases and digitally fabricated plywood structures, providing a unique gathering space made with the most advanced robotic construction. The artwork is unique and controlled solely by the owner, so no other source is able to provide these specific pieces for exhibition, therefore the agreement is processed in accordance with Single Source Justification # 26-146. The artwork was installed in 2025 at Lake Cahuilla Veterans Regional Park, and the proposed agreement formalizes the long-term loan and ratifies the existing arrangement.

The Loan Agreement outlines the responsibilities of both the District and GOLDENVOICE, LLC ("Owner"). The loan is for a period of ten (10) years, with an option to extend for a period not to exceed ten (10) years upon mutual agreement. The Owner retains all copyrights but grants the District a license to use images of the art for non-commercial promotional purposes.

County Counsel has approved the Loan Agreement as to legal form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The installation of public art serves as a point of interest, encouraging residents and tourists to visit the area, which can lead to increased sales for nearby businesses. The public art piece will include interpretive signage, offering residents insights into the artist's process.

Additional Fiscal Information

On June 10, 2025, per minute order 3.6, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Executive Office to pay \$500,000 from the Unincorporated Communities Fund to the District to support additional improvements for Lake Cahuilla Veterans Regional Park. The Loan Agreement includes maintenance costs estimated at an annual cost not to exceed \$5,000, included in Fiscal Year 26/27 operating budget. A one-time direct payment of \$130,800 is provided.

The Single Source Justification documents have been reviewed by Riverside County Purchasing and Fleet Services.

**LOAN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE RIVERSIDE COUNTY REGIONAL
PARK AND OPEN-SPACE DISTRICT AND GOLDENVOICE, LLC FOR THE PUBLIC
ART DISPLAY OF "Monarchs by HANNAH"**

This Agreement is entered into this 3rd day of November 2025 by and between the Riverside County Regional Park and Open Space District, a park and open-space district created pursuant to the California Public Resources Code, Division 5, Chapter 3, Article 3 ("**RIVCOPARKS**") and Goldenvoice, LLC ("**Owner**"), with reference to the following facts:

RECITALS

A. The Owner desires to loan to RIVCOPARKS on a long-term basis an outdoor art piece entitled "Monarchs by HANNAH" created by HANNAH Design Office LLC (the "**Artist**"), which is comprised of various concrete 3D printed structures with digitally / robotically fabricated timber lattice structures, as further depicted in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein ("**Art Work**").

B. RIVCOPARKS desires to borrow Art Work from Owner to exhibit outdoors at a public place located at Lake Cahuilla Veterans Regional Park, 58075 Jefferson Street in the City of La Quinta, California as is more particularly described in Exhibit A ("**Display Site**").

C. The Art Work has already been installed at the Display Site pursuant to section 5, below, and the parties now desire to formalize and ratify the loan, care and display of the Artwork under the terms set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, including, without limitation, the mutual promises, conditions, and agreements set forth herein, RIVCOPARKS and the Owner agrees as follows:

1. **Loan.** Owner agrees to lend the Art Work to RIVCOPARKS, and RIVCOPARKS agrees to borrow the Art Work from Owner, for the purpose of exhibiting the Art Work at the Display Site. Nothing in this paragraph prevents RIVCOPARKS from choosing a different location for the display of the Art Work.

2. **Term and Display Period.** The term of the loan of the Art Work shall be for a period of ten (10) years starting on November 3, 2025 during which time the Art Work shall be displayed at the Display Site ("**Display Period**"). The Display Period may be shortened or extended in duration by mutual agreement between Owner and RIVCOPARKS. At the end of the Display Period, an extension agreement may be negotiated to extend the lease for a period of up to ten (10) additional year(s) ("**Additional Display Period**"). Notwithstanding the foregoing, RIVCOPARKS reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to remove from display or terminate the exhibition of the Art Work at any time by sending a written notice to the Owner of such decision.

3. **Ownership.** The Art Work is and shall remain the property of the Owner. Notwithstanding, the Owner grants to RIVCOPARKS the right of possession in the Art Work for the term and purposes set forth in this Agreement. If Owner sells the

Art Work during the term of this Agreement, under no circumstances shall the sale of the Art Work terminate or adversely affect RIVCOPARKS's rights hereunder including, but not limited to, RIVCOPARKS' right to custody and possession during the initial Display Term.

4. License Reproduction Rights. Owner hereby grants a license to the RIVCOPARKS, in perpetuity, the right to photograph, film, videotape, or otherwise depict the Art Work at any time during the Display Period and to use such photographs, film, videotapes, or depictions in the regular course of dissemination of information, promotion and publicity relating to the Art Work or RIVCOPARKS, including use of images of the Art Work on RIVCOPARKS' website. The foregoing does not grant RIVCOPARKS any reproduction rights, merchandising rights, rights to produce collateral materials or any secondary commercial exploitation of any photographs, film, videotapes or depictions it takes of the Art Work unless expressly agreed to by the Owner in writing. RIVCOPARKS agrees to give "on-loan" and "artistic" credit to the Owner and the Artist, respectively, concurrently with all such uses.

5. Transportation, Installation, Maintenance, and Removal

5.1 Owner shall be responsible for arranging transportation and delivery of the Art Work to the Display Site, and for arranging installation of the Art Work at the Display Site, provided that RIVCOPARKS shall reimburse Owner for all expenses incurred by Owner in relation to such transportation, and installation of the Art Work at the Display Site ("**Installation Expenses**"), with the maximum amount of such reimbursable Installation Expenses not to exceed the amounts set forth in the budget attached as Exhibit B. The Installation Expenses shall be paid by RIVCOPARKS to Owner within 90 days upon receipt of Owner's invoice with documentation of Owner's expenses as required by RIVCOPARKS following the completion of the installation.

5.2 Owner shall prepare the Display Site for the display of the Art Work and such preparation shall include the preparation, grading and installation of necessary foundations for the various components of the Art Work.

5.3. RIVCOPARKS shall be responsible for procuring, installing, and paying for lighting of and landscaping for the Art Work. RIVCOPARKS shall install signage, which provides "on-loan" and "artistic" credit to the Owner and the Artist, respectively.

5.4. Owner shall be responsible for the maintenance of the Art Work, provided that RIVCOPARKS shall reimburse Owner for all expenses incurred by Owner in relation to the maintenance of the Art Work ("**Maintenance Expenses**") with the maximum amount of such reimbursable Maintenance Expenses not to exceed the amounts set forth in the budget attached as Exhibit C. The Maintenance Expenses shall be paid by RIVCOPARKS to Owner on a rolling basis, within ninety (90) days upon receipt of Owner's invoice to be issued not more frequently than monthly during the Display Period. The parties agree that no maintenance other than occasional cleaning and painting should be required unless tagged, painted or vandalized, in which case solvent will be necessary to remove any paint.

5.5. Owner shall be responsible for arranging the removal of the Art Work from the Display Site and all associated costs except when the removal occurs

prior to the end of the Display Period as the result of the RIVCOPARKS' notification to Owner that relinquishes possession of the Art Work pursuant to Section 2 above, in which case RIVCOPARKS shall be solely responsible for all costs related to such removal.

6. Liability for Damage or Injury

6.1 RIVCOPARKS shall at all times during the term of this Agreement insure the Art Work for its fair market value, which the Parties agree is Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) under a policy of insurance for risk of physical loss or damage. Owner is responsible and shall be liable for any damages, loss or destruction that may occur during transportation and delivery of the Art Work to and/or from the Display Site, and during installation and removal of the Art Work if Owner is performing the installation and removal.

6.2 Owner shall indemnify and hold RIVCOPARKS harmless from any and all claims, losses, damages, injuries, and/or liabilities, including reasonable attorney's fees and costs, arising out of or related to Owner's willful misconduct or negligent transportation, delivery, installation, and/or removal of the Art Work if Owner is performing the installation and removal, or Owner's breach of its representations, warranties, or obligations hereunder, except to the extent attributable to RIVCOPARKS' negligence or willful misconduct.

7. Addresses for Notices.

Any notice, demand or document which any party is required or may desire to give or deliver to the other hereunder, shall be in writing and may be delivered personally or given by United States mail, certified, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, addressed as follows:

Either party shall have the right to designate a different address by notice similarly given. Any notice, demand or documents to be given, delivered or made by United States mail shall be deemed to have been given or delivered or made two (2) days after the day on which the same is postmarked by the United States mail, addressed as above provided, with postage thereon fully prepaid. Owner shall notify RIVCOPARKS promptly in writing if there is any change in ownership of the Art Work (whether through inter vivos transfer or death) or if there is a change in the identity or address of Owner. RIVCOPARKS assumes no responsibility to search for Owner if it cannot be reached at the address of record.

8. Entire Agreement. This Agreement represents the entire Agreement between RIVCOPARKS and Owner and no other representations, whether oral, written or implied, have been made nor may be relied upon by RIVCOPARKS. This Agreement may be modified only by writing made after the date of this Agreement and signed by both RIVCOPARKS and Owner.

9. Governing Law. This Agreement is entered into in and shall be governed by the laws of the State of California.

10. Contract Administration. The General Manager or their designee shall administer the terms and conditions of this Agreement for RIVCOPARKS.

11. Third Parties. RIVCOPARKS shall have no obligation to any third parties under this Agreement.

12. Headings. The caption headings of the various sections and paragraphs of this Agreement are for convenience and identification only and shall not be deemed to limit, expand or define the contents of the respective sections or paragraphs.

13. Severability. Invalidation of any provision contained herein or the application thereof to any person or entity by judgment or court order shall in no way affect any of the other covenants, conditions, restrictions, or provisions hereof, or the application thereof to any other person or entity, and the same shall remain in full force and effect.

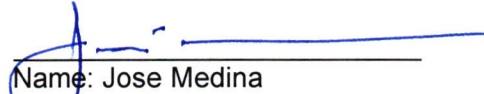
14. Successors and Assigns. The terms of this Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the respective heirs, successors in interest and assigns of the Parties hereto.

15. Language for Use of Electronic (Digital) Signatures. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which will be an original, but all of which together will constitute one instrument. Each party of this Agreement agrees to the use of electronic signatures, such as digital signatures that meet the requirements of the California Uniform Electronic Transactions Act ("CUETA") Cal. Civ. Code §§ 1633.1 to 1633.17), for executing this Agreement. The parties further agree that the electronic signatures of the parties included in this Agreement are intended to authenticate this writing and to have the same force and effect as manual signatures. Electronic signature means an electronic sound, symbol, or process attached to or logically associated with an electronic record and executed or adopted by a person with the intent to sign the electronic record pursuant to the CUETA as amended from time to time. The CUETA authorizes use of an electronic signature for transactions and contracts among parties in California, including a government agency. Digital signature means an electronic identifier, created by computer, intended by the party using it to have the same force and effect as the use of a manual signature, and shall be reasonably relied upon by the parties. For purposes of this section, a digital signature is a type of "electronic signature" as defined in subdivision (i) of Section 1633.2 of the Civil Code.

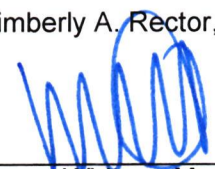

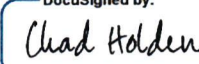
